It must again be stressed that no attempt has been made by either the Defendant in this matter, or the Defendant in the other matter whom he represents, to repay any of the amounts claimed by the Plaintiff or to engage in dialogue to settle their debts and, as such, as the matters have been listed, it is our intention to strenuously object to any further delay in the matter occurring because of any apparent matter that the Defendant's Attorney has to attend.
