AFFIDAVIT

I, VERNON O. SMITH, Q.C. Attorney-at-Law of Smith & Smith, Attorneys-at-Law, Gladstone House, Pinfold Street, Bridgetown in the parish of Saint Michael MAKE OATH AND SAY as follows:-

1. I was the Attorney-at-Law for the Defendant in this matter.
2. On 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2002 the firm Cottle Catford & Co. came to an end by written agreement between the partners Allan Watson, Joyce Griffith and Philip Nicholls.
3. At the time of the dissolution of the partnership there were two accounts outstanding in the name of the Defendant.
4. On the 30<sup>th</sup> day of January 2004, Cottle Catford & Co by its former partner sued the Defendant by way of Supreme Court Suits No. 151 of 2004 and 152 of 2004 claiming the respective sums of \$168,847.08 and \$96,300.00 together with interest thereon and costs. The said claims were acknowledged and admitted by the Defendant as is evidenced by the Acknowledgment of Service filed in the said actions by the Defendant on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2004.
