- 5. On the 13<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2004, by my Attorney-at-Law, Vernon O. Smith of Smith & Smith, Attorneys-at-Law, I filed an Acknowledgment of Service of the said writ of summons herein acknowledging service thereof and stating that I did not intend to contest the proceedings and that I intended to apply for a stay of execution against the judgment entered by the Plaintiff.
- 6. On the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2004 the Plaintiff entered judgment against me for the sum of \$168, 847.08 together with interest thereon at the rate of 8% per annum from the 19<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2004 until payment and costs in the sum of \$1,608.25.

  (i) On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2007 I by my said Attorney-at-Law paid to Allan St. Clair Watson the sum of \$73,629.53 in respect of Suit No. 151 of 2004 and \$41,993.70 in respect of Suit No. 152 of 2004 in full satisfaction of her 35% share (inclusive of all interest accrued thereon) of the said judgment debt entered against me by the Plaintiff as is evidenced by the duly stamped office copy of the signed receipt dated 16<sup>th</sup> April 2007 issued to me by the said Allan St. Clair Watson. I refer a copy of the said receipts hereto as Exhibit 'VS3' and 'VS4' respectively.
  - (ii) On the 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 2007, I by my said Attorney-at-Law paid to Joyce Griffith the sum of \$59,422.13 in respect of Suit No. 151 of 2004 and \$38,594.05 in respect of Suit No. 152 of 2004 in full satisfaction of her 33% share (inclusive of all interest accrued thereon) of the said judgment debt entered against me by the plaintiff as is evidenced by the duly stamped signed receipts dated 16<sup>th</sup> April, 2007 issued to me by the said Joyce Griffith. I refer to a copy of the said receipts hereto as Exhibit 'VS1' and 'VS2' respectively.
  - (iii) Under cover of letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2007 written by my said Attorney-at-Law and delivered to Philip V. Nicholls on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2007, I paid to Philip Vernon Nicholls the sum of \$108,491.16 in full satisfaction of his 32% share (inclusive of all interest accrued thereon and the sum of \$1,608.25 taxed costs) of the judgment debt entered against me by the plaintiff in Suits No. 151 and 152 of 2004. I refer a copy of the said letter dated 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2007 written
