We write once again to raise the concerns of the Public Service Vehicle operators with regard to the handling of the situation involving the following:

- Use of the Bus Stop at Tudor Street, St. Michael, outside the Central Police Station
- The continued restriction of privately operated Public Service Vehicles from Baxters Road, part of their traditional outbound journey from Cheapside Terminal

Sir, we have to point out that the committee formed to address these issues was recommended by the Minister of Transport as the most expedient method. Additionally, since early April, it was decided that June 01, 2016 was attainable as an implementation date for the decision arising from the committee's deliberations.

Unfortunately, we must also put on record, the lack of responses to our telephone calls and written correspondence. We believe that more will be achieved with the participation of the committee and would appreciate confirmation of your commitment to the agreed process by letting us have your suggestion for a date to resume these important discussions.
