ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS**

Barbados and the Republic of Liberia,

Desirous of strengthening the existing friendly relations between their Governments and peoples, and promoting and intensifying their cooperation in the political, economic, social and cultural domains, with a keen focus on tourism and heritage,

Guided by the principles and purposes of the United Nations Charter and other norms of international law, particularly those pertaining to the promotion of international peace and security, the respect for State sovereignty, equality among States, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States,

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961, and as of the date of the signing of this Communiqué.
