It is also very clear that you have not read my e-mails to your staff, to you, or to BRA in full because had you done so, you clearly would not be making the false assertion that you have made about my correspondence with your firm.

Anyone with an internet connection can look at Counsel's background and achievement, so if you were going to question my ability, you could at least do some research before making foolish remarks. Especially, when this is conveyance, not the type of work done by Counsel.

I apologise in advance for approaching you in this way, but I need your help as a matter of urgency and thank you in advance for taking the time to read this e-mail and the attachment. I am the nearly, former owner of 72 Cherry Avenue Sunset Crest St James where you act for the purchaser in the transaction.

I write to make the unusual request that you take over from my Attorney and represent me as well as the buyer for the remainder of the transaction. Although this is an unusual request when I explain the reason below, I am confident that you will understand why the request is being made.

I Believe That Mrs Leodean Worrell is Unwell.

Over the past few weeks, Leodean has become very, threatening and personally abusive in her correspondence with me. Yesterday she telephoned me at home, and shouted at me and made some bizarre accusation about my mental state. Very regrettably my 11-year-old daughter, could hear her through the receiver because she was so loud. I have attached some e-mails to give you an indication of the nature of the correspondence that I am referring to. The latest of which came yesterday. Daphne,

With all due respect, you are in need of help and the sad part is you are completely oblivious of that fact.

The help that I came to your firm for, is legal assistant and your failing in your duty. The tone and content of your e-mails have become increasingly personal, abusive and strange. This is very odd given that, you do not know me in a personal capacity. In the strange ranting phone call that you made to me in the UK on Friday, you used language that shows you to be a grotesquely nasty person. You attacked my mental health, you claimed I was mad, even though you know nothing about my personal circumstances, or how your behaviour might have affected me and my family. If you were a woman who acts with dignity and common human kindness you would not use language of that nature to anyone at any time.

Poor mental health has become an epidemic in our society today and most good employers are now taking steps to ensure that their staff mental health are protected. Indeed, in the UK, it is accepted that mental health problems have become a real issue in our profession and steps have been taken to provide support. I see no shame in poor mental health and I would happily do anything in my power to assist anyone that I come across and know them to be suffering with their mental health. I am fortunate in that, I have a very large family, parents and grandparents, a strong and kind circle of friends and of course my husband, if I ever find myself seeking mental health treatment of any kind of support. I have the expertise and kindness in my circle of friends and family to provide that.

Sending a message of this nature to me attacking my alleged poor mental state and copying your staff in, is the behaviour of someone without the requisite ethical, legal or moral compass. Does it occur to you how this might affect your own staff reading this very nasty e-mail? You have gone too far Leodean, this is not the behaviour of a competent and respectful Attorney, you are showing a horrible example of the Barbados legal community to the world and you have not done yourself any favours in behaving so badly.

I warn you once again, your conduct has already cause losses. I urge you to focus on your obligation as a lawyer and do not send me any more e-mail of this nature. I informed you already that your comments are unwelcomed.

Know that you have finally gotten independent advice that shows everything we told you in relation to bra was correct. (confirming yet again your need for help].

I have no idea what you mean by this, whatever other legal advice I have taken is my business. Your behaviour has resulted in me seeking advice and support from a number of sources because I am concerned whether I want to continue to deal with you. I am considering my options and in view of this, your last e-mail to me. I have not ruled anything out.

Let us just try and complete your transaction so that neither I nor my staff have to endure your less than stable and rational responses.

I need you to send me an e-mail telling me what you are going to do and when. I will then decide

how I wish to proceed and with whom. I need the e-mail before the end of the day on Monday please. I don't have to take your abuse, another firm of Attorney can conclude the transaction for me, if necessary.

Again let me be patiently clear do not address. My staff speak only to me, and do so only when your sentences thoughts ideas and suggestions actually makes sense.

I am happy to use another firm going forward . Please provide the e-mail that I have requested above. My communication with your firm have been largely by e-mails, they have all been polite and professional. There have been a few short telephone calls between your Secretary and I, all of which were polite and professional on both ends and followed up by e-mails. There has been one phone call with Jalisa on Friday, which was equally polite, and was also followed up by e-mail. The communication were not expressing thoughts and ideas, your my Attorney selling my property, the correspondence were about the sale. You are trying to create a false impression to justify your abusive and bullying behaviour.

I want all correspondence with you to be by e-mail going forward. If I allow you to conclude this transaction, the only phone call with me would be to confirm bank details of the FX company that will deal with the transfer. The phone call would need to be recorded. It is now highly unlikely that I will trust you to conclude this transaction. I would need considerable safeguards and assurances from more than one source before I trust you with such a large sum of money.

We were sent this link below to read about your behaviour to other people. It is clear that you are a rude and abusive person but been rude and abusive to your client is a breach of your contractual and ethical obligation.
